## BEWL WATER FISHERY WEEKLY REPORT week ending: 17 - May - 18

There has been a small improvement in the fishing , possibly helped by cooler temperatures and overcast weather conditions. At the time of writing, any method anglers appear to be having more success than fly anglers. Rod average for the week based on returns, is 3.81.

A further 1500 rainbows were trickle stocked this week.

Best areas for boat fishing , again based on returns, have been Chingley, the Main Bowl and Seven Pound Creek.

Bank fishing is still challenging. Best areas to try are Canoe Club Corner, the front of the playground , Bramble Point and Seven Pound Creek.

Cormorants, Buzzers and Boobies have been the more successful flies.

The second round of the AMFC took place at Bewl on Wednesday 16 May.

30 Anglers caught 100 fish giving a rod average of 3.3. Winners were Greylags with a total bag weight of 72lb 10oz.
