My apologies for this first report for a while. As many of you are aware, conditions in the latter part of the summer up to, and including most of September, have been far from ideal for our Rainbow Trout. Water temperature peaked around 24c and the fishing was subsequently dire. Bewl have continued to stock during this period and around 9000 fish have been delivered since August 20th, so our current population may be perceived as a healthy one.

Last Saturday saw the final round of the 'All major fly fishing clubs' deciding promotion and relegation from the three divisions. Tunbridge Wells were top rods with a total of 27 fish with Richard Denney bagging his eight fish limit for a total weight of 19lb 3oz. In addition, there were six other limit bags and the competition average was 3.9. Best fish went to J. Bromilow, who recorded a Trout of 4lb 2oz

On the 'any method' front, several good bags have been caught in the main bowl, with fish showing in most areas. Bewl regular Maxim took 8 on a Mepps red fluro last Friday. Others have found good Perch and Pike in 'Seven Pound Creek' and a specimen Rudd of 3lb 2oz from near the cages.

Predator season is almost upon us with October 30th being the first day of certain restrictions being lifted. Please ask in the lodge for further details.
