The weekend of the 23rd and 24th saw all of our boats out onto the water with all anglers enjoying some fantastic sport on the back of the opening day success. The Fishing dropped off somewhat at the beginning of the week as the sun came through and the wind direction changed a few times in as many hours. That said, the fly anglers enjoyed results in many areas, particularly in the latter part of the week. There have been some small local buzzer hatches which is fairly unusual for Bewl at this time of year with some of our regular anglers seeing buzzers being ingested after spooning fish. Friday saw some very bright conditions which saw the fish head deeper particularly in the afternoon. With 54 boats booked again each day this weekend and some very warm weather forecasted it could be a challenge to find the fish. A further 1800 bulldog rainbows were stocked this week with fish being distributed across the reservoir, a further stocking will take place next week.

Flies fishing well have been buzzers and green and black flies again although most patterns have been successful. There have been well over twenty 4lbs fish reported over the last few days which were not stocked so it seems some overwintered fish are quite active in areas.

Best spots for boat fishing have been Chingley wood and rosemary lane.

Best spots for bank fishing have been Montys seat, Dunsters and Seven Pound Creek.
