

BEWL WATER FISHING REPORT

| End of November 2025 - by the Bewl Phantom 🐉



Overview

It was a very quiet week at Bewl Water, with only a small number of anglers heading out. However, the few who did make the trip enjoyed excellent sport, achieving a rod average of 3.6 fish — clear evidence that the reservoir is fishing far better than the turnout suggests.

Stocking Update

We have stocked 2,500 trout this week, ensuring there are plenty of fresh, hard-fighting fish throughout the reservoir.

Water Conditions

The water level is slowly rising, slowly improving access around the banks and opening up more productive drifts for boat anglers. Water clarity is ok and temperatures remain ideal for active trout.

Depth & Tactics

Fish are being found at 8–15 feet, with many takes coming to slow-intermediate and midge-tip lines. Productive flies include black & green lures, orange blobs, mini snakes, as well as natural patterns like buzzers and diawl bachs fished slowly.
